Grammy Award-winner **JEFF TYZIK** is recognized as one of America's most innovative pops conductors. Now in his 20th season as Principal Pops Conductor of the Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra, Tyzik also currently serves as Principal Pops Conductor of the Seattle Symphony, Detroit Symphony, Oregon Symphony, Florida Orchestra and Vancouver Symphony. During the course of his tenure in Rochester, Tyzik has written over 180 works for the orchestra as well as commissioned works for other organizations. Highly sought after as a guest conductor, he has appeared with the Boston Pops, Cincinnati Pops, New York Pops, Florida Orchestra, National Arts Centre Orchestra and Royal Scottish National Orchestra as well as the major orchestras of Philadelphia, Los Angeles, Dallas, Detroit, Milwaukee and Toronto. A native of Hyde Park, New York, Tyzik began his life in music at nine, when he first picked up a cornet. He studied both classical music and jazz throughout high school, and went on to earn both his bachelor's and master's degrees from the Eastman School of Music, where he studied composition/arranging with Radio City Music Hall's Ray Wright and jazz studies with the great band leader Chuck Mangione, both of whom profoundly impacted him as a musician. Committed to performing music of all genres, Tyzik has collaborated with such diverse artists as Tony Bennett, Art Garfunkel, Dawn Upshaw, Marilyn Horne, Arturo Sandoval, The Chieftains, Mark O'Connor, Doc Severinsen, John Pizzarelli, Billy Taylor and Lou Rawls, and created original programs that include the greatest music from jazz and classical to Motown and swing.
